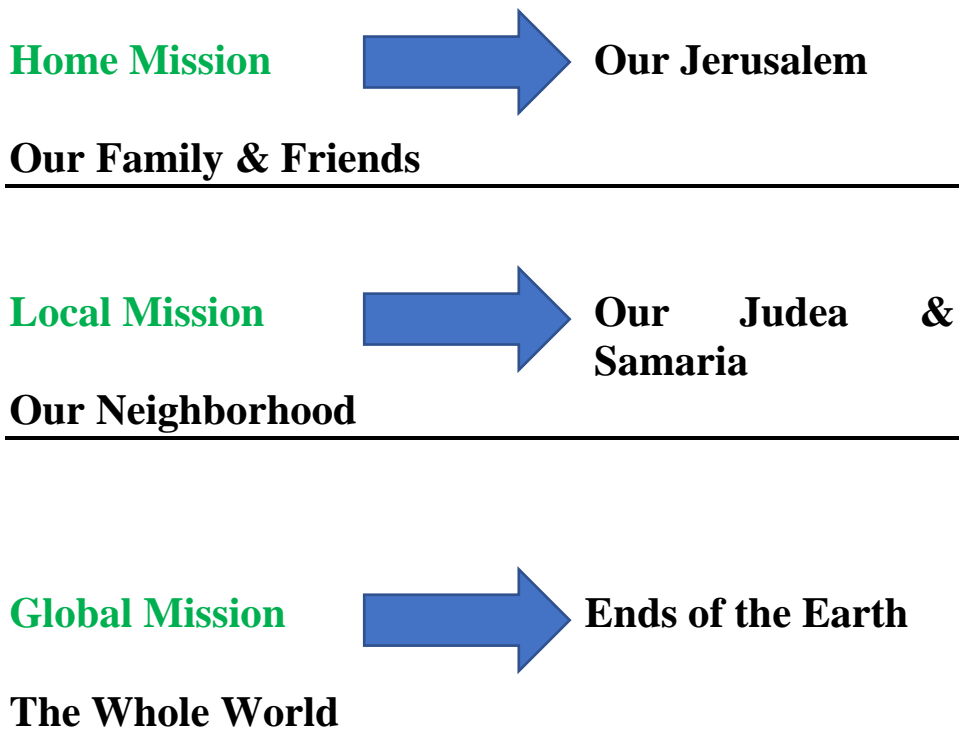

HOME MISSION



You are the center droplet and the droplets around you are your Jerusalem.

**Every believer has a responsibility to reach out to his/her Jerusalem
(Family, Friends and Close Relatives)**

There are many reminders in God's Word that urge us to seek the salvation of our families.

“Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household.” Acts 16:31

“By faith Noah, when warned about things not yet seen, in holy fear built an ark to save his family.”

Hebrews 11:7

“Anyone who does not provide for their relatives, and especially for their own household, has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.” 1 Tim. 5:8

“Give me a sure sign that you will spare the lives of my father and mother, my brothers and sisters, and all who belong to them—and that you will save us from death.”

Home Mission Strategy

1. **Church leadership is key. Without the involvement of leadership, the vision is destined to fail.**

“It is like the precious ointment upon the head, that ran down upon the beard, even Aaron's beard: that went down to the skirts of his garments;” Psalms 133:2

2. **It is advisable that two leaders from the leadership team be among the vision bearers.**
3. **From the church members (outside the leadership) who have a heart for the gospel, two or three should be selected to work with the two leaders as vision bearers.**
4. **These four or five vision bearers will work within the local church to promote this vision, bridging the gap between the leadership and the congregation.**
5. **Each local church can adapt the implementation of this vision in a way that suits their congregation.**

PHASE I – Giving Birth to the Vision

Global Good News Mission can assist the local church leadership in:

- **Ensuring the vision is birthed within the local church.**
- **Communicating the vision to the congregation so that it takes root in the heart of every believer.**
- **Implementing the vision among the believers.**
- **Monitoring and evaluating the ongoing process.**
- **Providing training as needed.**

PHASE II – Implementation

- **Helping believers to see the vision.**
“Where there is no vision, the people perish.”
Proverbs 29:18
- **Assisting believers in the local church to fill out “Reaching Our Jerusalem” form (See the Sample on the last page).**
- **The filled forms will be kept under the local church for prayer and follow-up. The one who filled the form will have a copy (can be electronic).**
- **Encouraging focused prayer for the souls listed on the forms. Each believer should pray for the souls they have listed. Prayer groups, Pastoral staff, etc., should focus on praying for these souls. It is like a chicken warming up her eggs so that it would hatch!**
- **The Prayer should be based on:**
 - **Knowing that the salvation of these souls is the will of God. (John 3:17, 2 Peter 3:9, Acts 16:31, 1 John 5:14-15)**
 - **Asking the Lord to send laborers to these souls. (Matthew 9:37-38)**
 - **Binding the enemy that has these souls blinded. (Matthew 12:29, 2 Cor. 4:4)**

PHASE III – Follow Up & Tracking

- **Developing strategies for how each believer can reach the souls they have listed with the gospel. Believers are primarily responsible to pray for those they have listed. The vision bearers in the local church will work with the individual believer to develop various strategies to reach the souls listed on the forms. Team work!**
- **As the Holy Spirit leads, using various methods (personal testimony, tracts, phone calls, social media, using believers close to the listed person, etc.) to ensure the gospel reaches them.**

“How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in?” Romans 10:14

- **As souls get witnessed to, and get saved, the database will be continuously updated so that the whole church can rejoice and give praises and continue to pray together.**
- **After souls are prayed for consistently, some will surely come to the Lord. Follow up has to be done in order to rejoice with the whole congregation as souls are saved.**
